Please would you choose 3 jobs in order of preference, that you would like and say why you would be good at them and I will try to match everyone with a responsibility.

School Council

You are ambassadors for our school and you will represent your fellow students by seeking their opinions and sharing them with the school leadership team.

You may be required to help make changes to the way we do things in school and to help make important decisions.

You need you be a good listener, respectful of other's opinions and confident to speak in front of others.

Assembly Crew

You will be responsible for setting up the hall for assembly in the morning. Making sure benches, chairs, table, equipment, etc. are all ready.

You may also be required to lead a simple assembly when the teacher is not there.

You will need to be organised, punctual and reliable.

Office Worker

You will be responsible for helping staff in the office to sort and count out letters to go home, deliver them to classes and occasionally answering the telephone at lunchtime.

You will need to be efficient, organised and sensible

Playground Buddy

Buddies will help to supervise children on the playground, help younger children to play games together, sort out disagreements between children, look out for children on their own, etc.

You will need to enjoy playing with younger children, enjoy organising activities, be caring and observant.

Reading Buddy

Reading buddies will listen to younger children read, talk about books and stories with younger children and write comments in the children's journals.

You will need to enjoy reading and working with younger children, be patient and helpful and be encouraging and positive.

Digital Leader

Digital leaders are children who will learn about new IT software and also become the experts in school in using the It equipment available. They will be responsible for training other children and adults and for running clubs for younger children.

You will need to have a passion for IT and enjoy teaching others new skills! It's not all about you using the equipment!

Peace Pal

Peace Pals will be responsible for solving minor disagreements between children and trying to help them to work through the issues.

Peace Pals will receive training in Conflict Resolution.

You will need to be very patient, calm, a very good listener, able to see things from other points of view and want to help others.

Librarian

Librarians will be responsible for keeping the library tidy and books in the correct place. You may also need to stamp new books with the school stamp and help to put them on the shelves. You may be able to run the library for some sessions and help children to choose books and check them out.

You will need to be tidy, organised and enjoy books and reading.

Eco Warrior

Eco warriors will be responsible for making sure all taps are turned off and all lights are off when people have left rooms. They will also be responsible for litter picking (using snazzy litter pickers) and encouraging others pick up their own litter! They would be responsible for promoting recycling in any way possible.

You should have an interest in making our school a 'greener' place to be. This is a creative role and we would welcome good ideas!

<u>Shopkeeper</u>

Shopkeepers would help to collect all dojo bank books and dollars and keep bankbooks updated. They will also sell items in the dojo shop and deduct dollars from children's bankbooks.

Corridor Monitor
