As mathematicians we will be improving our multiplication and division skills and developing our problem solving too. We will know how to count in 2s. 5s and 10s. We will also look at data and recording findings in tables and charts.

As geographers we will be learning about the UK and its place in the world, describe our locality and where it is and know how addresses work and what we use them for.





In RE we will be reading and looking at different Bible stories. We will discuss how these stories help to shape what Christians believe and the way they behave.

As designers we will designing and making vehicles.

As scientists we will be looking at plants. We will look at how they grow and the different parts that make up a plant. We will also discuss edible plants and how they can be a source of energy for us.

As historians we will look at the way people travelled in the past compared to today. We will develop our awareness of differences between the past and present.

As writers we will be writing letters and information texts. This will include learning how to set out different types of writing.

As musicians we will be trying to make tunes using patterns of sound via technology.

In our class this half term we will also be completing our phonics screening then discussing changes and moving on. This will include a few days of transition in class 2.

As computer programmers we will be looking at using different sound sequences through apps. We will also be using technology to complete our own research.
