As scientists we will be investigating Electricity - Could you be the next Nintendo Apprentice?



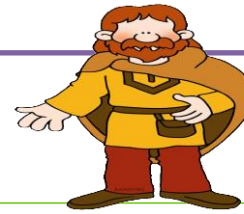
As musicians we will have singing lessons from a professional singer.
