

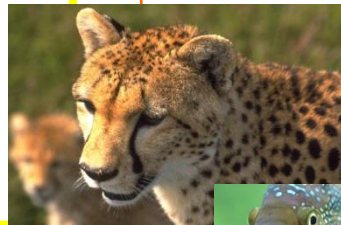
As Writers and Readers we will focus on:
