Nell Bank Residential Trip - Class 4 - 8th and 9th March 2018

We are taking our Year 4 children on a residential visit. We have found that this is an invaluable experience for the children, both socially and educationally.

The visit will be on 8th and 9th March 2018. We will be away for one night. We will be visiting Nell Bank, near Ilkley.

Staff have already made preliminary visits to the venue, which is superb, and offers lots of scope for fun, educational and confidence-building activities in a secure, comfortable and picturesque setting. The activities will be led by qualified Nell Bank staff. We will take members of school staff too.

We will travel by coach from school on the morning of Thursday 8th March and return in the afternoon of Friday 9th March.

The children will sleep in dormitories with bunk beds. They will need to bring a sleeping bag or duvet, plus a pillow. Tea on Thursday, along with breakfast and lunch on Friday, will be included in the price. As there are limited cooking facilities I am proposing fish and chips for tea. Please let me know if there are any allergy issues.

The cost of the residential visit will be £45.33. We are informing you now so payments towards the trip can be made in installments if preferred. Payment can be made on line via Parent Pay or Paypoint at your local shop, as well as in cash via school.

Parents will be entitled to a remission of charges if in receipt of any of the following benefits.

- Income support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Support under part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, where the parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit.

However you can still make a voluntary contribution to school if you feel you are able to do so.
