We hope you have had a good week. In Reception we have been learning new phonemes and graphemes – ck at the ends of a word and e, u, and r. We have also been trying to learn tricky words **the** and **to**.

Next week our phonemes will be: h, b, f/ff, l/ll, and ss. Once the children know the sounds really confidently and can blend these sounds together, they will be reading! Please do practice this with your children as it makes a massive difference to their progress if we work together.

Our reading scheme books are called BUG CLUB. You can access some books online as well as actual books. I have allocated some books to your children, so they can practice blending and talking about the pictures and the story. There are little quizzes for your children to complete, to ensure they have understood the story. I will also send a list of words you can make with the sound cards we gave you.

Tricky words this week are: no, go and I, as well as continuing to practice the and to.

In number, we are working on counting accurately and counting objects and matching to the correct number. We are also looking at 2D shapes in the environment and making patterns.



If you get any unusual shaped boxes that you don't need, please bring them to school so we can look at the different shapes.

We hope you enjoyed the open morning the other week. We are hoping to have another next half term. Think SPARKLE!
