Dear Parent/Carer

Class 1 are planning a trip to Legoland Discovery Centre in Manchester.

The visit will take place on 7th December 2017. We will be leaving school by coach in the morning at 8.50am and arriving back at school before home time.

Children need to be in their full uniform and a packed lunch and drink will also be required, all in a disposable bag, as we will be throwing it away. If your child would like a school packed lunch, please let me know.

The overall cost of the visit, including travel and insurance will be £16.34. We are informing you well in advance so payments towards the trip can be made in installments if preferred.

If your child has any medical conditions, can you please complete a medical form (available from the office). If your child suffers from travel sickness can you please give your child a tablet before they arrive at school and if they need a tablet for the return journey, again can you please let me know.

The Education Reform Act (1988) states that you are under no obligation to contribute towards any school visit, however if insufficient funds are received we will have no option but to cancel the arrangements. We must stress that being unable to make a contribution towards the visit will not affect your child's right to attend. You are though, able to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost.
