As mathematicians we will be extending our understanding of number systems as well as refining our skills in multiplication and division. We will learn how to measure angles and use our data handling skills when investigating in science. As Artists we will develop the skills of portrait drawing in order to create wanted posters and look at digital photo-fit images and create our own using technology.

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As computer scientists we will create journalistic videos to report crime.

We will also continue to develop our skills are computing programmers using online coding software.

As historians we will be investigate the crimes of Guy Fawkes and his associates. Would he have got away with it these days?



As theologians we will be learning about the Bhuddist faith with a focus on how they worship. As scientists we will be investigating the question: *Could you be the next CSI investigator?* We will look at forensic investigations and the chemistry involved in solving crimes.

As language speakers we will continue to develop our French vocabulary. As writers we will study persuasive writing and like this to our topic of deforestation.
