Well done to Harlie who is racing through the online Bug Club books. She has read a lot! Don't forget to look on the front of your child's diary to find the log in details. It has really helped Harlie to make good progress. Please keep revising the sounds with your children so they become really confident.

In number we are continuing to count 1-1, to recognise numbers to 10 and 20 and some beyond and we are beginning to look at 3D shapes - cone, cube, sphere, cuboid, cone and cylinder. Have a look around your house or when you go shopping for these shapes in the environment.
