
As mathematicians we will study Decimal numbers, percentages and Algebra.

Science based topic linking learning with the Great Plague of 1665.


As scientists we will study disease and micro-organisms and how our society's knowledge and understanding of disease and cures have developed. We will look at the journey through our bodies in detail.

As athletes we will be learning gymnastics.




As musicians we will continue to sing with Bradford Music and Arts group.
