### As Mathematicians

We will be incorporating our topic into problem solving and reasoning activities. We will be applying our mathematical skills into different tasks which will involve investigating shapes in our gift shop. This will involve calculating, measuring and ,working with 2D and 3D shapes.

## <u>In Knowledge and Understanding</u> of the World, we will be:

Looking at why people go to the seaside? What do they do there?

We will also investigate the history of the seaside and look at how things have changed over the years, We will look at how people travel to the seaside and how travel options have changed over the years.

Continuing to develop our handwriting and spelling skills. We will develop our use of different types of sentences in our independent writing - commands, exclamations, statements and questions.


### As Readers we will:
