As mathematicians we will be extending our understanding of place value and decimals. We will also deepen our geometry skills.

As Artists we will take inspiration from Henri Rousseau's 'Surprise' and create our own paintings of the rainforest. We will develop brush skills as well as investigating different mediums.

As geographers we investigate the question:
Why should the rainforest be important to all of us?
With a focus on environmental issues such as deforestation.



As computer scientists we will create Rainforest themed games using coding software

As athletes we will be develop our game skills in school, and we will be swimming every Tuesday (fortunately, not in the Amazon!) As musicians we will be learning to play un tuned percussion with the Samba teacher. Music native to South Americal

As language speakers we will continue to develop our French vocabulary.

As scientists we will be investigating the question: Do all plants and animals start life as an egg?

As writers we will create narrative stories with a Rainforest Theme.

We will also use our skills of persuasion to write letters about deforestation.

As designers we will use fabrics and sewing skills to create our own stuffed toys.
