Yorkshire Museum of Farming Trip

We would like to take the children on an educational trip to the Yorkshire Museum of Farming in York.

During the day the children will get involved in the making of early types of clay pottery, learn how our ancestors grew crops, ground grain to make flour and learned the essential skills of hunting. They will also have the opportunity to try their hands at pre-historic art and handle some original artefacts!

The trip is on 2nd April 2019 and we will be travelling by coach. We will be setting off from school at 9am prompt and returning back to school at approximately 4pm.

They will need a packed lunch in a disposable bag so we can throw everything away after lunch and don't need to bring lunchboxes etc back with us. Lunches can be brought from home or ordered from school, but I will send more information out nearer the time.

The cost of the trip including coach travel is £25.66. We are informing you now so payments towards the trip can be made in installments if preferred. Payment can be made on line via Parent Pay or Paypoint at your local shop, as well as in cash via school.

The Education Reform Act (1988) states that you are under no obligation to contribute towards any school visit, however if insufficient funds are received we will have no option but to cancel the arrangements. We must stress that being unable to make a contribution towards the visit will not affect your child's right to attend.
