Class 4 - Herd Farm Residential Trip - 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> April 2019

We are taking our Year 4 children on a residential visit. We have found that this is an invaluable experience for the children, both socially and educationally.

The visit will be on 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> April 2019. We will be away for one night, staying at Herd Farm Residential & Activity Centre, Eccup Reservoir, Leeds.

Staff have already made preliminary visits to the venue, which is superb, and offers lots of scope for fun, educational and confidence-building activities in a secure, comfortable and picturesque setting. The activities will be led by qualified Herd Farm staff.

We will travel by coach from school on the morning of Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April and return in the afternoon of Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April. More information about the trip will be sent out nearer the date.

The cost of the residential visit will be £60.40. We are informing you now so payments towards the trip can be made in installments if preferred. Payment can be made on-line via Parent Pay or Paypoint at your local shop, as well as in cash via school.

Parents will be entitled to a remission of charges if in receipt of any of the following benefits.

- Income support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Support under part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, where the parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit.

However you can still make a voluntary contribution to school if you feel you are able to do so.
