Dear Parents/Carers

I have booked a trip to The National Science and Media Museum in Bradford on **9th November 2018** to learn more about the work we are covering in class.

Your child will need to wear their school uniform and we will leave in the morning after school has started and return before the end of the school day.

If you are bringing a packed lunch from home, can you please bring this in a disposable bag. If your child requires a school packed lunch, can you please inform the school office.

If your child has any medical conditions, can you please complete a medical form (available from the office). If your child suffers from travel sickness can you please give your child a tablet before they arrive at school and if they need a tablet for the return journey, can you please indicate on the medical form.

As the museum is free, the cost of the coach will be £5.80. Payment can be made on line via Parent Pay or Paypoint at your local shop, as well as in cash via school.

Education Reform Act (1988) states that you are under no obligation to contribute towards any school visit, however if insufficient funds are received we will have no option but to cancel the arrangements. We must stress that being unable to make a contribution towards the visit will not affect your child's right to attend. You are though, able to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost.
