

As Mathematicians we will

Focus on statistics and properties of shape including problem solving. Rockstar Maths will continue 3 times weekly to develop recall of the 2/5/10 times tables and corresponding division facts. We will also continue to learn how to tell the time to the nearest quarter of an hour on an Analogue clock.

As Writers we will :

Look at the features of reports and narrative. We will be using different sentence types in our writing including statements, commands, exclamations and questions. We will be using full stops, exclamation marks and question marks to punctuate our writing. We will continue to learn spellings as part of our spelling lessons. As Readers we will: Continue to read a range of fiction and non-fiction books. Children are continuing to develop their written answers to comprehension questions. We will look at stories from Africa and continue to enjoy class story time.

PE

This half term we will focus on Invasion Games. We will look at basic skills and also use collaboration for learning how to play fairly. Our daily mile run will continue to support children in building stamina and maintaining a healthier lifestyle.

In Knowledge and Understanding of the World, we will be:

Using maps, atlases and globes to identify places in the United Kingdom and Africa. We will make comparisons between the two places and investigate the weather and lives of people and animals.

In RE we will continue to look at the similarities and differences in Islam and Christianity.
