Dear Parent/Carer

We have booked a visit to Yorkshire Farming Museum this will enhance the learning we will be doing this term.

The visit will be on Friday 28th February 2020 and we will go by coach.

Your child will need to wear their school uniform and children need arrive at school at 8.15am, as we will be setting off from school at 8.30am. We will be arriving back to school at approximately 3.10pm, depending on traffic.

If you are bringing a packed lunch from home can you please bring this in a disposable bag. If your child requires a school packed lunch, can you please inform the school office.

The overall cost of the visit, including travel and insurance will be £26.78 and this includes the cost of a workshop. We are informing you well in advance so payments towards the trip can be made in instalments if preferred by Parentpay or in cash at the school office.

The Education Reform Act (1988) states that you are under no obligation to contribute towards any school visit, however if insufficient funds are received we will have no option but to cancel the arrangements. We must stress that being unable to make a contribution towards the visit will not affect your child's right to attend.
