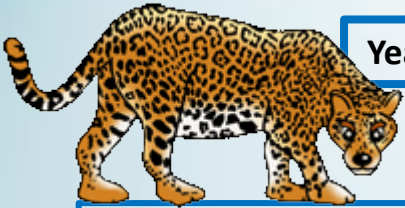


Year 5 – autumn term 1 –Why should the rainforest be important to us all?

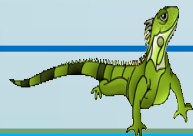
