

As Writers and Readers we will focus on:

Phonics phase 1 - We will complete a range of games that involve alliteration.

Phonics phase 3 - We will apply digraphs/trigraphs to our reading and writing. We will play a range of games that apply these sounds.

We will continue to look at letter formation and use cursive handwriting.

We will share books about healthy eating and people who help us. We will draw pictures and write sentences about these. We will look at the features of non-fiction texts.

We will have a range of costumes to support our role play on people who help us. We will also have a fruit shop where we will follow and write our own lists. We will look at Oliver's Fruit Salad and Oliver's Vegetables when looking at healthy eating.

As caring people we will be:

Looking at SEAL - Good to be me!

Through our circle time we will talk about different emotions and think of things that make us feel like this. We will take turns to talk about this and listen to others. We will share stories and draw pictures of these emotions. We will be thinking about why we celebrate Easter.

As Scientists:

We will continue to make observations of the weather outdoors discussing any snow or ice.

In ICT we will be using familiar programs to draw pictures of people who help us. We will also use this to practise our names.

We will look at Google Earth to find out about different environments.

In the water area we will look at different materials that float and sink.
