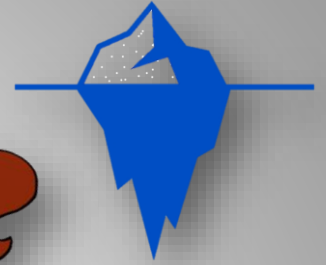

Will we ever see the water we drink again?

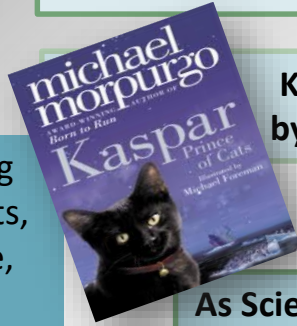


In Maths we will be focusing on: Algebra, converting units, perimeter, area and volume, and ratio
