In the Summer term, Class 5 will be studying the rainforest in Geography. For part of this, we will be learning about the animals and creatures that live there.

One of Class 5's trips this year will take place in school, and on the 25th April, we will be enjoying a visit from some experts in predators to study them closer.

The children will, amongst other things, take part in reptile based educational talks, handling sessions and team building. They will see: a wide array of reptiles and invertebrates from snakes to frogs to tarantulas.
