Dear Parents/Carers,

Our Science topic in the spring term is based around the units 'material's' and then 'Earth and Space'.

I have booked a trip to 'Magna Science Adventure Centre' in Rotherham where the children will spend their time learning about aspects of the two units! They will take part in two workshops and have the opportunity to explore the building.

The trip is on Wednesday 16th February 2022 and we will be travelling by coach. If your child experiences travel sickness, they can take one tablet to help prevent this. Children need to be in their full uniform and to be at school earlier than usual at 8:15am. We will be back to school later than usual at approx. 4pm.

A packed lunch and drink will also be required, all in a disposable bag, as we will be throwing it away. I will send more details nearer the time.

The cost of the trip including coach travel is £23.17. We are informing you now so payments towards the trip can be made in installments if preferred. Payment can be made on-line via Parent Pay or Paypoint at your local shop, as well as in cash via school.

Under the terms of the Education Reform Act (1988) we are not able to charge for educational journeys (transport/insurance/entry fees) which occur during school time. You are though, able to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost. We are legally allowed to charge for board and lodgings (with the exception of the note below). If you choose not to contribute this will not lead to your child being excluded from the trip; however it may lead to us cancelling the visit.

Parents will be entitled to a remission of charges if in receipt of any of the following benefits.

- Income support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Support under part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, where the parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit.
