In mathematics we will continue to learn about addition and subtraction and then we will learn about multiplication and division

In History we will do a study of a natural disaster; looking at the causes and the aftermath of an event.

Our Science lessons will be all about Rocks. Our significant person will be Mary Anning.

In guided reading we will be reading a fiction story about a volcanic eruption: 'How the Giant Stirred' and an information text about Volcanoes.

In physical education we will be learning all about handball including movement, coordination and how these fit together.

For enrichment, we will be enjoying a visit from 'One day creative'. We will learn all about volcanoes and natural disasters.
