Dear Parent/Carer

During the Summer Term, Class 2 are planning a trip to Filey.

The visit will take place on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2022. We will be leaving school by coach in the morning at 9.15am and arriving back at school at approximately 4.15pm.

The overall cost of the visit, including travel and insurance will be  $\pm 20.00$ . We are informing you well in advance so payments towards the trip can be made in installments if preferred.

The Education Reform Act (1988) states that you are under no obligation to contribute towards any school visit, however if insufficient funds are received we will have no option but to cancel the arrangements. We must stress that being unable to make a contribution towards the visit will not affect your child's right to attend.

I wanted to give you some more information about the day itself.

1. Children can wear their own clothes (t-shirt and shorts with sweatshirt/cardigan would be ideal). Please also make sure children have a waterproof coat/jacket.

2. Please supply sun cream for your child and place this in their back pack. On the day of the trip please can you also apply sun cream to your child in the morning before school (even if it isn't sunny). School will re-apply their sun cream in the afternoon, (unless you require a specific cream for your child due to allergies).

3. Children will wear a school baseball cap (with school logo) so they can be identified easily. A hat from home will <u>not</u> be required.

4. A small backpack with a packed lunch in a disposable bag and a bucket and spade (that will fit in the bag) would be appropriate.

5. Children may bring  $\pm 2.50$  for an ice cream (in a named envelope) on the day. These will be collected by the group leaders.

We will be setting off at 9.15 am approx and will return to school at approx 4.15pm dependent on traffic. If we are going to be later than 4.15pm we will notify you by text.

If your child has any medical conditions can you please complete a medical form (available from the office). If your child suffers from travel sickness can you please give your child a tablet before they arrive at school which will also last for the return trip.
