Dear Parent/Carer,

As you may be aware, we are due to expect very high temperatures next week and we would like to ensure your child is well protected from the heat whilst at school. Before school:

- Parents/Carers are encouraged to ensure children apply sunscreen before they
 come to school, and to bring this with them in order to re-apply it themselves when
 necessary
- Children to bring a sun hat which covers their head, neck and ears for PE lessons and when outside at break times

During School:

- We will encourage the children to stay in the shade during playtimes and we will limit the children's exposure to the sun during the hours of 11am-3pm
- As usual, children will have access to water throughout the day and we will be encouraging them to drink at regular intervals.
- PE classes will, as far as possible take place in shaded areas or inside spaces.
 Children will be reminded to wear their sunhats and have water bottles with them. If the heat is excessive, alternative activities will be arranged for your child in a classroom space.
- Each classroom will have a fan to promote air flow within the classroom
- Children can come to school in their PE kits (shorts and t-shirts) to ensure they keep cool throughout the day

We will endeavour to keep you updated should anything change during the day and we will be monitoring the temperature closely.
