Dear Parent/Carer



In the Spring term, Class 2's trip will take place in school, on the 6 March 2024, we will be enjoying a visit from the drama teacher Alex Fellowes.

Mr Fellowes has years of experience in teaching history through drama and performance. He has a wealth of knowledge in history, on many different time periods.

The cost of the drama workshop is £3.87 per child. We are informing you in advance so payments towards the workshop can be made in instalments if preferred. Payment can be made online via Parent Pay or monies can be sent into school (clearly labelled).

Education Reform Act (1988) states that families are under no obligation to contribute towards the cost of school visits, however if insufficient funds are received we will have no option but to review and possibly cancel the arrangements. We must stress that being unable to contribute towards the visit will not affect your child's right to attend.

Parents will be entitled to a remission of charges if in receipt of any of the following benefits, and would need to discuss this with Mr Grant or the school office.

- Income support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Support under part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, where the parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit.
