Dear Parent/Carer

On Thursday 20 June 2024, we are going on a class visit to the Yorkshire Wildlife Centre in Doncaster. We will learn about where different animals live. We will take a tour of the wildlife park and have a picnic.

The cost of the trip is £25.62 per child. This includes travel, insurance and admission. We are informing you in advance so payments towards the trip can be made in instalments if preferred. Payment can be made on line via Parent Pay or monies can be sent into school (clearly labelled).

Education Reform Act (1988) states that families are under no obligation to contribute towards the cost of school visits, however if insufficient funds are received we will have no option but to review and possibly cancel the arrangements. We must stress that being unable to make a contribution towards the visit will not affect your child's right to attend.

Parents will be entitled to a remission of charges if in receipt of any of the following benefits, and would need to discuss this with Mr Grant or the school office.

- Income support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Support under part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, where the parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit.
