Dear Parent/Carer

Nursery, Reception and Class 1's trip will take place in school, on the 21 May 2024, and we will be enjoying a visit from a mobile farm.

The children will, amongst other things, take part in educational talks about the animals, feeding and handling sessions. They will see a wide array of animals. Please complete the slip below so we can see if your child has any new allergies, so that we can take the precautions needed to thoroughly enjoy this visit.

The total cost to parent/carers is £11.16. Payment can be made on line via Parent Pay or monies can be sent into school (clearly labelled).

Education Reform Act (1988) states that families are under no obligation to contribute towards the cost of school visits, however if insufficient funds are received we will have no option but to review and possibly cancel the arrangements. We must stress that being unable to make a contribution towards the visit will not affect your child's right to attend.

Parents will be entitled to a remission of charges if in receipt of any of the following benefits, and would need to discuss this with Mr Grant or the school office.

- Income support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Support under part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, where the parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit.
