



Year 6 Topic web Spring 2 - Summer 1



In maths, we will be looking at the relationship between fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also learn how to measure and calculate angles using a protractor.

In science we will explore electrical circuits and then move on to learn about the human circulatory system.

In writing, we will be using the novel *Kensuke's Kingdom* by Michael Morpurgo as a stimulus for our independent writing. We will continue to work on spelling, grammar and punctuation.

As artists we will use the 'painting with scissors' technique to develop our collage skills.



In religious education we will learn about Christianity and the associated festivals. We will then consider how growing up brings responsibilities.

In design technology we will be learning about Mechanical systems (Automata toys)

In history we will learn about the Titanic. This will include a study of historical sources to determine their reliability and investigate what life was like on board for different classes.
