Dear Parent/Carer

We are planning a trip to Born Explorers Forest School in Mirfield for our Nursery children. This trip will enable us to complete a range of outdoor learning activities based around our topic and support us in developing our confidence, social skills, language and communication, motivation and concentration, physical skills and knowledge and understanding.

The planned date for this trip is **Tuesday 8th July** and we would need children to arrive in school early at **11am**. We will return for the normal end of the day time of 3.15pm subject to traffic.

The cost of the trip is £12.83 per child. This includes travel, insurance and admission. We are informing you in advance so payments towards the trip can be made in instalments if preferred. Payment can be made on line via Parent Pay or monies can be sent into school (clearly labelled)

Education Reform Act (1988) states that families are under no obligation to contribute towards the cost of school visits, however if insufficient funds are received we will have no option but to review and possibly cancel the arrangements. We must stress that being unable to make a contribution towards the visit will not affect your child's right to attend.

Parents will be entitled to a remission of charges if in receipt of any of the following benefits, and would need to discuss this with Mr Grant or the school office.

- Income support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Support under part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, where the parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit.
