As geographers we will learn about South America and the Amazon Rainforest. We will study rainforests and their physical features.

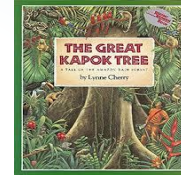
As writers we will study the books 'Oliver Twist' and 'The Tyger'.

As readers we will study the following themes: Roald Dahl, Light and Shadows, Ancient Egypt, Poetry and Songs.



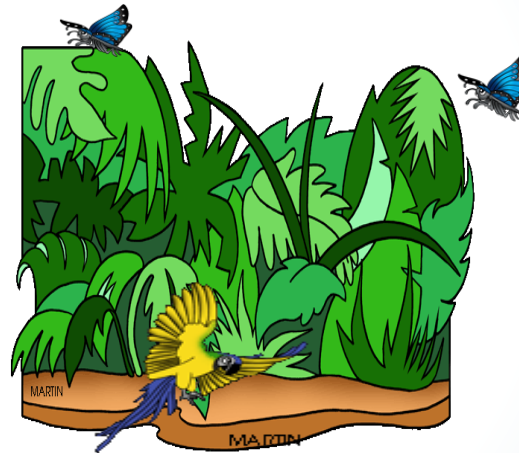
In computer technology lessons we will continue to study block coding.
